

## RULES OF PREPARATION FOR STOOL SAMPLE COLLECTION

### **Sample collection procedure**

- collect the **stool** in the relevant container/s
- fill the container to **half full**

Sample delivery procedure **in the morning** on the days established for sample collection:

- deliver the sample after registering at the reception desks to the Sample Collection Point during the opening hours
- Deliver the container/s to the Sample Collection Room staff

### **WARNING!**

For these types of test there is no need to modify your diet

Every stool sample must come from a discharge on different days

For these tests, the sample can be stored at 4°C and delivered within 4 days of collecting the sample
